Demonstrative Adjectives & Pronouns

- What are demonstratives?
 - They point out, **or demonstrate, which noun is meant.**

Which noun?
That noun!

Demonstrative Adjectives & Pronouns

- What are demonstratives?

| | Singular | Plural |
|---------|--------------------|---------------------|
| Closer | this (esta/e/o) | these (estas/os) |
| Farther | that (esa/e/o) | those (esas/os) |

Demonstrative Pronouns

- What is a demonstrative pronoun?
 - This is an amazing CD; I'm so glad you gave it to me.*
 - This replaces or refers to the CD .

Use sparingly.

1. Which is not a demonstrative?

- This
- That
- Them
- These
- Those

Demonstrative Adjectives

- What is a demonstrative adjective?
 - That plate is smaller than this one.*
 - That and this answer "Which plate?"*
 - The farther plate is smaller than the closer plate.

Almost always use a **noun** after a demonstrative.

1. That idea just occurred to me.
2. That just occurred to me.
